- Keep one of my pencils in your drawer for emergencies
- Remind me of due dates
- Provide me with visuals to support what you are saying

For homework & assignments:

- I will need to break long, written assignments into smaller sections
- I may need more time to complete my work
- I will need reminders for assignments and homework
- I will need to use my computer whenever possible
- I will need you to help me manage my time on a big assignment
- Please stay positive with constructive feedback
- If my work is incomplete, please don't assume I am being lazy
- Being able to use my script or cue cards so that I do not have to memorize

For tests:

- I will need a study guide to know what to focus on
- Please provide a word bank whenever possible
- Check in during the test to make sure I'm on the right track
- Make sure the first few questions on the test are questions I'll be able to answer
- When the test has been marked, please celebrate my accomplishments
- For math tests please give me an example of how each type of question is done
- Let me use a calculator when you're not assessing my addition/subtraction skills
